Residents Bill of Rights:

17. Every resident has the right to be told both who is responsible for and who is providing the resident’s direct care.

18. Every resident has the right to be afforded privacy in treatment and in caring for their personal needs.

19. Every resident has the right to,

i. participate fully in the development, implementation, review and revision of their plan of care,

ii. give or refuse consent to any treatment, care or services for which their consent is required by law and to be informed of the consequences of giving or refusing consent,
