Our Welcome Centre

Since the retirement building is not yet ready for tours, we have opened a temporary Welcome Centre located on Main Street inside the long-term care Village.

It opened on October 12 and since then, more than 100 people have inquired and shown interest in what retirement at Glendale Crossing is all about.

Our Welcome Centre is where you will find me each day, armed with detailed brochures, pictures, videos of other villages, floor plans and an open ear!

With the continued COVID 19 restrictions we are navigating, those wishing to come into the Village to see me must show proof of double vaccination and take a rapid test, confirming a negative result.

Our neighbourhoods

Our neighbourhoods allow you to choose the lifestyle option that best suits your current care needs. These options range from independent living to assisted care and memory care.

Living in retirement, residents have the choice to age in place, and that means **no more moving**! If or when more care becomes necessary, it is available right there within the Village.

There are five neighbourhoods whose design has been carefully crafted to accommodate the needs of its residents.

Ailsa Craig – Independent Living

Full kitchen; weekly housekeeping and linen laundry service; in suite washer and dryer; meal plans can be added.

Becker – Retirement Apartments

Kitchenette - lunch and dinner daily; weekly housekeeping and linen laundry service; in suite washer and dryer; breakfast can be added.

Williamsburg – Full Service Retirement

Three meals daily; medication administration; daily bed making; weekly housekeeping and linen laundry; weekly assisted bath or shower.

Egerton – Assisted Living

Three meals daily; medication administration; support with personal care; daily bed making; weekly housekeeping and linen laundry service; weekly assisted bath or shower.

Emma's – Memory Care

Safe, secure neighbourhood for residents living with dementia; three meals daily; medication administration; support with personal care; daily bed making; weekly housekeeping and linen laundry service; weekly assisted bath or shower.

Supplementary care and support can be added to all neighbourhoods.



The family

The key to what makes a Schlegel Village unique and special, is the Schlegel family themselves.

To the Schlegels, senior care is a calling. From the early roots planted by Wilfred Schlegel in the small village of Ailsa Craig to the Schlegel-UW Research Institute for Aging (RIA) – whose foundation was initiated by Wilfred's son, Ron to help further their goal of improving care for seniors through research and innovation – this family just sees things differently.

Village design

The Hallmark feature of the Schlegel Villages design is the Town Square and Main Street concept, which promotes social interaction and quality of life. The Town Hall, the Café and the Community Centre are focal points along Main Street, and the extensive use of windows and skylights flood the street with natural light on even the cloudiest of days.
