

## Signs and symptoms of heat illness



#### Heat exhaustion

If you or someone you are with experience any of these symptoms, immediately move to a cool place and drink fluids; water is best. Alert a registered team member as soon as possible.



Skin rash



Muscle cramps



Dizziness or fainting



Nausea or vomiting



Heavy sweating



Headache



Rapid breathing and heartbeat



Extreme thirst



Dark urine and decreased urination

#### Heat stroke



High body temperature



Confusion and lack of coordination



Dizziness or fainting



No sweating, but very hot, red skin



Heat stroke is a medical emergency – immediately report to a registered team member or call 911 if away from the Village. While waiting for help-cool the person right away by:

- Moving them to a cool place, if you can;
- Remove excess clothing (layers);
- Applying cold water to large areas of the skin; and
- Fanning the person as much as possible.


## Resident of the Month Sheridan Way
