## Long-Term Care Visitor Policy Changes November 16th, 2020

As an organization, the safety and well-being of our residents and team members has been our priority throughout this pandemic.

As of November 16th, the Ministry of Long-Term Care has updated its visitor policy to align with the province's COVID-19 Response Framework, placing public health regions into five levels. Villages located in regions moving into the *Orange-Restrict* and *Red-Control* levels will have additional restrictions in place for visits and absences. As always, **Villages declared in outbreak or residents in self-isolation will have the highest restrictions.**
